Troop 1288 completed their Brownie Pottery Badge at Color Me Mine studio in Norfolk in January, 2013. It was a great field trip and the studio did a wonderful job of hosting the girls and leading them in their badge. The troop used the private party room upstairs. Two women from the pottery studio worked with the troop and led the girls through all five parts of the Pottery badge. The girls each made a "slab bowl" and an ornament from clay. The girls got to paint their bowl and ornament, with lots of paint and glaze colors to choose from. The pottery needs about a week to fire the pieces, so then someone has to go back to Norfolk to pick up the work. The cost seemed really reasonable to me, \$12 or \$13/girl. You need to call ahead and reserve this for your troop, and pay a deposit.

I've done other "paint your pottery" places with girl scouts and just with my family. By going to Norfolk for this you give the girls the chance to make pottery (required for the badge), not just paint it. It was also nice that they let us use the private party room, which was not the case when we went to a different (closer) place.

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
